Objectives

- Understanding simple instructions in Hindi.
- Recognizing the letter and correct pronunciation.
- Learning names of different objects around them.
- Engaging children in simple conversation amongst themselves.
- Building vocabulary.
- Recognizing and reading Matras with correct pronunciation.
- Understanding simple questions and answers in Hindi .
- Being able to write simple words with/without Matras.



Syllabus

- Continuing from last year's letters practice we proceed to consonants and vowels, numbers, poems, name of colors, vegetables, fruits, etc this year.
- Grammar and basic knowledge.
- Opposites and singular-plural.
- Syunktakshar.
- Completing the story with given appropriate words.
- Picture composition and story telling.
- Listening to stories and songs.



Program

- Each group has two periods(2 hours) per week.
- These periods are dedicated to activities such as :
conversations, listening, games and other traditional story
developing to increase vocabulary, drama and actions,
reading, speaking, writing etc.



Learning through assignments

- Assignment are given once a week.
- They are usually an extension of their classroom learning.
- Story books are also given to the child for reading.
